

NC State Combo League Championships - Vendor Village

Background

For the second year in a row, the Greater Wilmington Tennis Association will host a NC State Combo League State Championships. Over 1200 players from across the state will come to Wilmington for 8 days of tennis, fun, food and social experiences. To further enhance the players experience this year, we are creating a totally new experience called the Vendor Village.

Vendor Village

The experience of the Vendor Village is to provide them the opportunity to do all three. The concept is to create a space where vendor's from the area and across the state can purchase a space to display their wares for sale on the Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday of the tournament. The range of the vendors could include clothing, jewelry, tennis equipment and accessories, food and drinks.

Vendor Location

The Vendor Village will predominately be at Althea Gibson Tennis Center at Empie Park. This location is central to all tennis matches and is the largest facility in our group. You may also set up at other public facilities one of the days, if you wish – Ashley High School (9 courts) and Odgen Park (6 courts) are the other two options. For an additional fee, you may set up for the Player Party at the Coastline Convention Center in downtown Wilmington on November 13. Space issues do not allow for any vendors on November 6.
